Invites application for Admission of aspirants to IAS/IPS and other Allied Services

Aspiring candidates appearing for **UPSC Civil Services Examination 2023**, can join Satyendranath Tagore Civil Services Study Centre (SNTCSSC) for a composite course for Prelims and Mains Examinations including Mock Tests and Mock Interviews.

SNTCSSC works with a long-term vision to provide best quality coaching at a nominal fee to ensure that students from West Bengal become successful at the IAS, IPS and Allied services exams.

- The course for the new batch for UPSC CSE 2023 aspirants will begin from June 2022.
- Classes will be held in physical mode. However, if the pandemic situation demands, we may shift to online mode of classes, as and when required.
- Course Fee is Rs. 1000 per month (Rs. 500 per month for SC, ST and OBC).
- A 2-stage Admission Test will be conducted, comprising:
 - a) 1st Stage - MCQ and Essay test (only those candidates who qualify in the MCQ Test will have their essay scripts graded)
 - b) 2nd Stage - Candidates who qualify in first stage will be called for interview. Final list will be published after the interview.
- Candidates who have qualified in the CSE (Preliminary) conducted by UPSC, in any year, are eligible for direct admission.

- **Please note that the current batch of students (SNTCSSC Batch 2022) are not eligible to apply for SNTCSSC Batch 2023.** However, current students will be provided required guidance as long as they are aspiring for the UPSC CSE.

Last date for submitting form is 11 April 2022, Monday, 3 pm.

Date of **ADMISSION TEST** will be announced on website.

The decision of the SNTCSSC in the process of selection of candidates will be final.
